

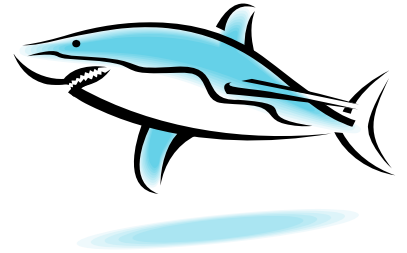


Mote Outreach Programs

Students will learn about the diversity of shark species and shark teeth through stories, crafts, and a shark tooth hunt.

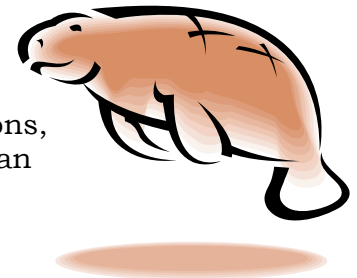


Grades K-2: Our Dolphin Neighbors

Hands-on activities and role playing will help students discover what scientists are learning about our dolphin neighbors in Sarasota Bay.

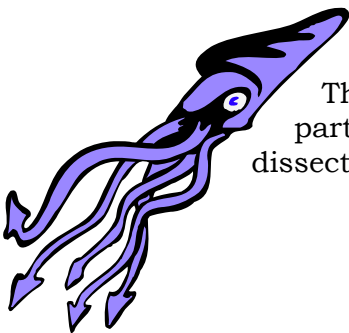
Grades 3-4: Mighty Manatees

Through the use of bio-facts, kinesthetic activities, and simulations, students will learn about the Florida subspecies of the West Indian manatee found in Sarasota Bay.



Grades 6-8: Spineless Sea

Through a squid dissection and taxonomic classification activities, participants will learn about marine invertebrates and proper dissection techniques.
